Details You Must Know!

- All preparation of ingredients and cooking is on-site only (**NOTHING** can be pre-prepped or pre-portioned i.e. chopped onions, meat cutting, spices, special sauce unless commercially canned or bottled i.e. catsup, tomato sauce, etc)
- No wild game may be used.
- Pre-soaking of beans must be done on-site or use canned beans.
- No electrical outlets will be available, except in kitchen for a limited time.
- Registration form and \$35 deposit fee must be collected by 7/31/2019.
- Meet at Chili Cook-off tent for set-up at 8am on 8/11/19. You may begin cooking no earlier than 8:30am and no later than 10am.

CONTESTANTS BRING

- A great sense of humor and the willingness to have a terrific time!
- All chili ingredients specific to your recipe.
- Contestants must provide cooking and storage equipment including coolers, stoves, propane burners, cooking thermometer, pots, towels, cooking utensils, cutting boards, etc.
- You must prepare a minimum of 8 quarts of chili to qualify.
- Food Handler's Permits are NOT required by contestants.
